

## **CMAX-09 Drill to be Held October 15, 2009**



The Bethesda Hospitals' Emergency Preparedness Partnership consisting of the National Naval Medical Center, Suburban Hospital (a member of Johns Hopkins Medicine), National Institutes of Health Clinical Center and the National Library of Medicine will conduct a mass casualty exercise in concert with the Joint Forces Headquarters National Capital Region Capital Shield 2010 (CS-10) from 13 to 15 October 2009.

CMAX-09 (Collaborative Multi-Agency Exercise) will be held on Thursday, 15 October, and is designed to test the medical readiness and response to a multi-casualty event that occurs on the National Naval Medical Center compound. The exercise will address the Joint Commission's six critical areas and will utilize the 15 National Planning Scenarios as the basis for design.
